## Panflutes (Expression Performance Registrations)

Congratulations on purchasing the new 'Panflute Expression Performance Registrations' software. A library of new registrations have been compiled to showcase the Panflute sounds within the OAS 7 factory sound library. Very often people want to be able to just sit down at their instrument, select a registration and play. Now you can.

IMPORTANT! This software only works with the OAS 7 software R7.41 upwards.

### Loading Instructions

#### Loading from CD/DVD.

1. Insert Panflute CD/DVD or USB device into the CD/DVD or USB drive.
2. Press the 'Settings' tab at the top right corner of the Main Display.
3. Press the 'OAS Database' Button in the central column of buttons.
4. A new small window will appear. Press the button marked 'Total Preset Manager' at the bottom of the centre of the new window.
5. The Total Manager will now be displayed.
6. Press the 'Import' button.
7. Select the 'Drive' that is your instruments CD/DVD or USB drive.
8. Once you have selected your CD/DVD or USB drive, the 20 Registration Total Presets will be displayed. Press the 'Select All' button.
9. Now that the Total Presets are highlighted in Red, press the 'Load' button.
10. A new window will be displayed. Please select a free slot to save the 20 Total Preset Registrations and press 'Save'. Please be aware that any Presets that currently occupy any of the slots that you select, will be overwritten. Please take care to select only free / vacant slots.

### Registration Recall

#### Using Quickload

1. From the Main Display press the 'Quickload' button.
2. Press the 'Presets' button at the top of the screen (Left hand side)
3. Make sure that you have 'User Presets selected for the menu displaying the Preset content of your OAS instrument.
4. Scroll down to the new 'Panflutes' in the slots that you have saved them to.
5. Select the Total Preset registration from the list and press the large 'Load' button in the bottom right hand corner.

#### Using 'Easy Preset'

1. From the Main Display press the 'Easy Preset' button.
2. Select the User Bank on the right hand side to navigate to the new registration Total Presets.
3. Simply select the desired registration displayed on the Easy Preset display for the entire instrument to be loaded instantly!

### **1. Andean Panflute**

The sound of the beautiful Andes mountain panpipe. The Andean Panflute is a local, traditional form of the famous Panflute.

### **2. Attack Panflute**

This Panflute sound includes a reedy bamboo attack, when the player plays.

### **3. Bass Panpipe**

Typical South American Panflute, including the sound of Sub-Pipes (Bass Panflute Footages)

### **4. Breathy Panflute**

This registration features a very airy, breathy attack and ambient tone.

### **5. Chillout Panflute**

This registration is ideal for Chillout music. You'll soon be thinking of beaches, beautiful sunsets and far-away places with this beautiful sound.

### **6. Eastern Panflute**

This registration captures the sound of the incredibly beautiful Japanese Panflute. This sound is perfect for beautiful eastern love ballads.

### **7. Golden Gate Panflute**

This registration builds upon the GG Panflute sample. The original sample comes from the WERSI Spectra Golden Gate / Lifestyle range of organs from the early 90's. This Panflute can be found on many records during this period.

### **8. Haunting Panpipe 1**

As the name suggests, an ethereal Panflute sound, perfect for the Atlantic Trade Winds... gentle, calm and mysterious.

### **9. Haunting Panpipe 2**

A variation of the above registration.

### **10. Jameos Panflute**

A Panflute in the style of the Claudia Hirschfeld composition 'Jameos del agua'. Beautiful and breathy.

### **11. Panflute 1**

A regular Panflute sound that is perfect for most types of music.

### **12. Panflute 2**

A variation of the above registration. The Panflute is one of the most versatile sounds for solo / melody lines.

### **13. Panflute Double Set**

A Chromatic Double set of Panflutes, like the Peruvian Mountain double sets.

### **14. Panflute Echoes**

A long delayed (echo) Panflute. Perfect for James Last or a haunting melody.

### **15. Peruvian Panflute 1**

A South American variant of the famous Panflute producing country.

### **16. Peruvian Panflute 2**

A variation on the above registration.

### **17. Pretty Panflute**

A pretty Panflute registration complete with twi-light sparkling bells.

### **18. Small Panflute**

A small Folk Panflute. Ideal for Irish music.

### **19. Tibetan Panflute**

Tibet is one of the most mysterious countries in the world. The people of the Tibetan foothills favour the incredibly airy and 'blue' sound of the beautiful Panflute.

### **20. Zampona**

Perfect for the Lonely Shepard by James Last.
